

- Opening of the Besshi Copper Mine; permission 1691 granted for use of timber from nearby forests.
- The Large-Scale Reforestation Plan was 1894 established. The Besshi mountains were revived through large-scale reforestation.
- Organization and start of the first private "Operation 1903 Plan (Forestry Plan)"
 - → Establishment of "Sustainable Forestry" principle
