CBD CoP 14 – Sharm El-Sheikh/Egypt

Wednesday, 28 November 2018, 13.00 – 15.00 h

Over the last year WWF Germany worked with experts of various civil society organizations to discuss the status of the Vision, Mission, Strategic Goals and Aichi Targets of CBD's current Strategic Plan 2011-2020. Results of the discussion and the pertinent report will be presented to participants of COP-14. The main guiding questions were whether targets should remain, be adjusted or replaced. Proposals of new and additional targets have been considered as well as how future biodiversity targets could be linked to the SDGs. Some ideas were elaborated to improve the implementation and governance of the future strategy.

The third workshop aims to exchange views on how to address the request in CBD/SBI/REC/2/19, para 7: civil society organizations are invited to submit by 15 December 2018 initial views "on the aspects of the of the scope and content of the post-2020 global biodiversity framework, including (a) the scientific underpinning of the scale and scope of actions necessary to make progress towards the 2050 Vision; and (b) a possible structure for the post-2020 biodiversity framework;"

The project team likes to capture final views to prepare a submission by 15th December 2018.
