

## Launching the Japanese version of the Aichi Biodiversity Targets Guide

The Japan Committee for IUCN launched new materials for promoting national implementation of the Aichi Biodiversity Targets, named "The guide to Aichi Biodiversity Targets: Take Action for World Promise and 20 targets (Japan version)". This guide based on latest global guidance of Aichi targets. NGOs, Business, local government and others can give many hints for future actions for the Aichi Biodiversity Targets.

It is not just a translation of the Global Aichi Biodiversity Targets Quick Guide, but many ingenious attempts; Yes-No charts, which enable to find the relationship of your activities and Aichi Biodiversity Targets, a list of useful links, 39 activities as examples of actions with beautiful photos and so on.

This publication is one of key project under <u>Double 20 campaign</u> (Nijyu-maru PROJECT, in Japanese), which collects commitments for the implementation of the Aichi Biodiversity Targets by local governments, businesses and civil society. As of October 2013, 151 organizations have declared their actions as a contribution to each Aichi Biodiversity Target.
