## The CMS \& AEWA Experience with Online Reporting

- Online Reporting System - part of first DELC KM I Project (ended in 2008)
- Developed by UNEP-WCMC for CMS \& AEWA
- Online National Report Generator - for all MEAs
- System to enable Secretariats to build online reporting tool themselves
- No Analytical Tool yet - was not part of KM I, but requested from Parties
- Clear mandate from our Parties to continue working with UNEPIDELC and WCMC to develop it further
