

#### 1. **Opening and registration**

The Capacity-building workshop for Europe on ecosystem conservation and restoration to support achievement of the Aichi Biodiversity Targets will be held from Monday, 2 June to Friday, 6 June 2014on the Isle of Vilm, Germany.

The workshop will start at 9:00 a.m. on Monday, 2 June and registration will take place from 8:30 a.m. at the workshop venue.

Check-in will take place at the workshop venue on Sunday, 1 June 2014 as participants are expected to arrive on the evening prior to the workshop. The formal opening of the workshop will be at 9:00 a.m. on Monday, 2 June at 9:00 a.m.

#### 5. General information on and access to the Isle of Vilm

The Isle of Vilm is located about 300 km from Berlin or Hamburg. Delegates to the workshop will arrive on 1 June, some will travel via Hamburg, some via Berlin. It will be necessary to travel by train to Lauterbach/Mole, the harbour village close to Vilm from either airport. From Lauterbach/Mole you must then take a ferry to the Isle of Vilm. From the Lauterbach/Mole station, you can walk to the pier where the ferry boat to the Isle of Vilm departs.


On the evening of 6 June, you will travel from Lauterbach/Mole to Berlin or Hamburg and stay there overnight to enable you to catch an early flight the next day (7 June).

Please see attached document (Annex A) for train connections and other transportation information to and from Berlin Tegel Airport and Hamburg Airport. In case you have to buy a train ticket though, please **do buy a return train ticket** since there is no vending machine in Lauterbach.

# Ferry to Vilm

From Lauterbach/Mole you can walk to the BfN pier where the ferry boat to the Isle of Vilm leaves (see map below and the attached travel information or at the Academy's web site at <u>http://www.bfn.de/0607\_kontakt+M52087573ab0.html</u>; please, also watch out for signposts). The ferry is free of charge.

On Sunday, the ferry runs at 13.15, 14.15, 16.10, 17.10, 18.10 and 20.10 from Lauterbach/Mole to Vilm.



#### Cash

Please bring some money in cash with you so that you will be able to pay necessary costs during your travel to Vilm as well as for refreshments during the workshop.

#### 6. Visa information



Participants from countries listed below require a Schengen entry visa for Germany and are strongly advised to contact the nearest German diplomatic or consular mission **as soon as possible** in order to secure the required entry visa in a timely manner, prior to departure. It should be noted that airline companies will deny boarding in the absence of a valid visa.

# 7. Hotel information



The accommodation for the participants of the workshop has been pre-booked at the International Academy for Nature Conservation. The cost of accommodation and meals per day is as follows:

- Single room: 58.00€
- Double room: 43.00€ (price per person)
- Cost of full board (Breakfast, lunch, dinner): 24.00€
- Morning and afternoon/tea/coffee, etc.: 4,00€

Some participants may have to lodge in Lauterbach, however, ferries will run frequently (10 minutes ride). Lodging costs in Lauterbach may vary slightly. #### 9. Weather and time zone information



In June temperatures on the Isle of Vilm usually ranges between a maximum of +18°C in the daytime and a minimum of 7°C at night. The standard time zone is GMT/UTC + 2 hours.

The currency in Germany is the Euro ( $\notin$ ). The current exchange rate as at 9 May 2014 is US \$1 =  $\notin$ 0.73 and  $\notin$  1 = US \$1.38 (rates are subject to change).
