- 2001-present
 - 20 countries
 - \$ 6.95 million in GEF resources through UNDP
- In 2005, third national report
 - 16 countries
 - \$ 0.35 million in GEF resources through UNDP
- Into 2008

-3 countries, \$ 0.96 million with \$ 0.548 million of co-financing.

- Countries received NBSAP/ Add-on/ CHM through UNDP: Bangladesh, Bhutan, India, Maldives, Iran, Mongolia, Korea, Cambodia, Malaysia, Philippines, Cook Islands, Fiji, Kiribati, Marshall Islands, Micronesia, Nauru, Niue, Palau, Tonga, Samoa
- Countries currently proposed for NBSAP/Add-on/CHM/ Third National Reports funding through : East Timor, Thailand, Tuvalu
- Countries received funding to prepare Third National Report to CBD: Bangladesh, Bhutan, Cambodia, Iran, Kiribati, Maldives, Mongolia, Nauru, Niue, Palau, Philippines, Marshall Islands, Samoa, Sri Lanka, Tonga, Viet Nam
