Any proposed Headline Indicator for which data is not already available for a minimum number of countries (e.g. 40-50 countries), either today or in e.g. the next year, should not be eligible to meet the headline indicator criteria. As data improves over time, when the data availability for a particular indicator reaches the minimum threshold for eligibility as a headline indicator, the AHTEG could evaluate it, and make a recommendation for the CBD COPs to consider at their next meeting. It seems premature, to agree to certain Headline indicators, at CBD COP15, if the data is not yet readily available. (Just because a methodology for an indicator may already exist, it does not mean the indicator is operational. If it is not operational, then it does not serve it's purpose.
