

Regional Capacity Development Workshop for the Caribbean on NBSAPs Nov 3 – 7, 2008 Trinidad

- *The Development Control and Planning Act No. 14 of 2000, section 26(2) of 2006 for St. Kitts/Nevis makes provision for Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA).
- The Terms of Reference for conducting the EIA are set by the Department of Physical Planning and Environment which ensures that Biological Diversity among other issues are considered.

 The National Physical Development Plan of 2006 airmarks special areas for environmental protection

purpose of maintaining scenic and aesthetic features

- protection of biodiversity.



- The National Environmental Strategy (NEMS)
 - addresses issues of Biodiversity Conservation and Protection.

- The OECS Protected Areas and Associated Livelihoods (OPAAL) Project
 - based on the protection of Biological diversity endemic to St. Kitts and Nevis and the Lesser Antilles.
 - The project is financed by the World Bank.
 - The project area consists of the central forested mountain areas of St. Kitts and covers an area of 12, 500 acres.

- *A proposal was put forward for St. Kitts and Nevis under the Global Environmental Facility (GEF)
- Resource Allocation Funding for the establishment of a Marine Management Area
- Protection of marine Biodiversity in St. Kitts and Nevis.

- ◆ The National Conservation and Environmental Protection Act of 1987
 - focus on the protection of Biodiversity in St. Kitts and Nevis.

- There are a number of proposals for the establishment of protected areas which would also focus on biodiversity.
 - Eg. of protected areas are SEP, Wingfield water shed and Brimstone Hill

* The recommendations of the National Biodiversity Strategy and Action Plan (NBSAP) has been used as a guideline in the development of numerous policy and project documents for St. Kitts and Nevis.
