Workshop Objectives







- 1) Facilitate national implementation of the Strategic Plan for Biodiversity 2011 2020, including by providing building capacity for setting national biodiversity targets
- 2) Provide countries with capacity building for reviewing, updating, revising and implementing NBSAPs; these NBSAPs are to serve especially as an effective tool for mainstreaming biodiversity into broader national policies
- 3) Facilitate active learning opportunities and peer-to-peer exchanges for National Focal Points and persons in charge of implementing and revising NBSAPs.

- Adoption of national targets in line with the Strategic Plan by 2012;
- 2) A new generation of updated and revised NBSAPs, adopted as policy instruments and fully integrated into national planning processes by 2014;
- 3) Effective sharing of knowledge, practices and technologies in support of the implementation of the Convention.
