Workshop Objectives

- 1) To facilitate national implementation of Strategic Plan for Biodiversity by assisting Parties to develop national biodiversity targets;
- 2) assist in reviewing, updating, revising and implementing NBSAPs, to serve especially as an effective tool for mainstreaming biodiversity into broader national policies;
- 3) facilitate active learning opportunities and peer-to-peer exchanges for National Focal Points and persons in charge of implementing and revising NBSAPs.

Expected Outcomes:

- 1) Adoption of national targets in line with the Strategic Plan for Biodiversity [by CoP11 in October 2012];
- 2) A new generation of updated and revised NBSAPs, adopted as policy instruments and fully integrated into national planning processes, by CoP12 in 2014 **at the latest**;
- 3) effective sharing of knowledge, practices and technologies in support of the implementation of the three objectives of the Convention.
