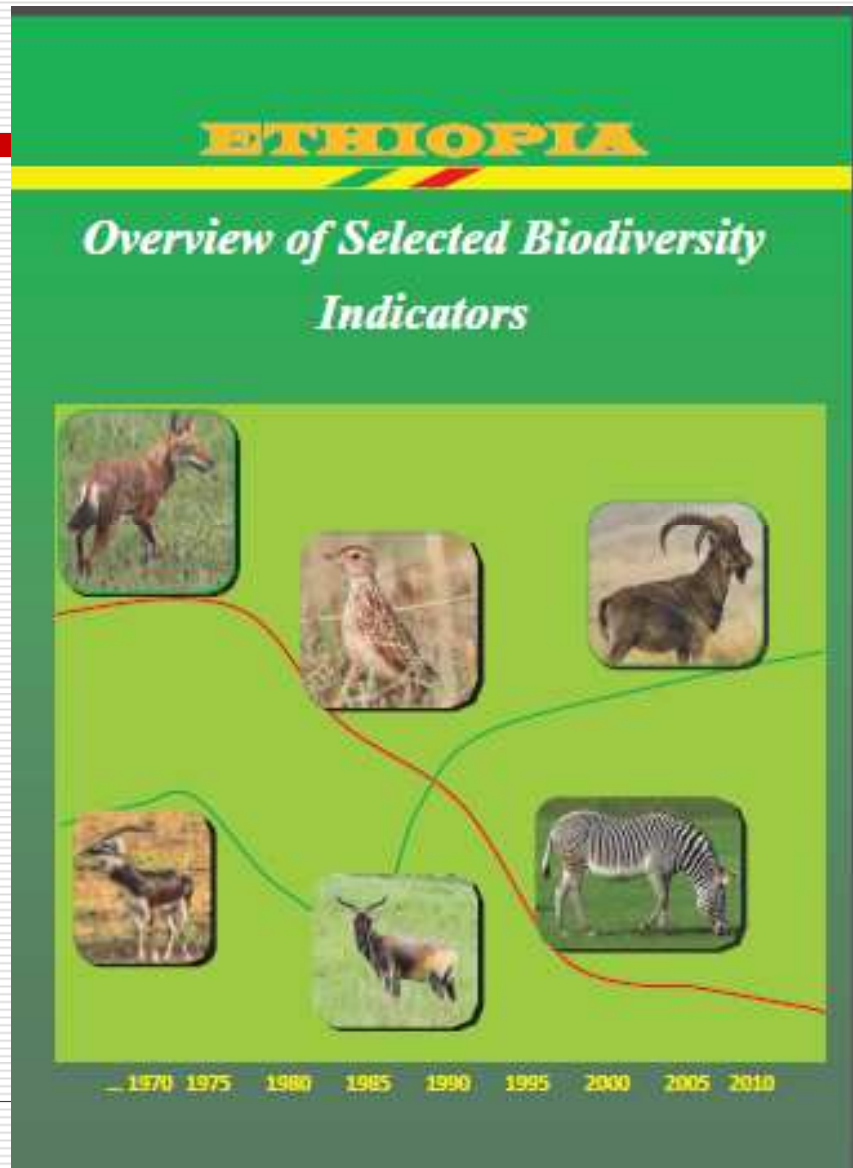
Achievements

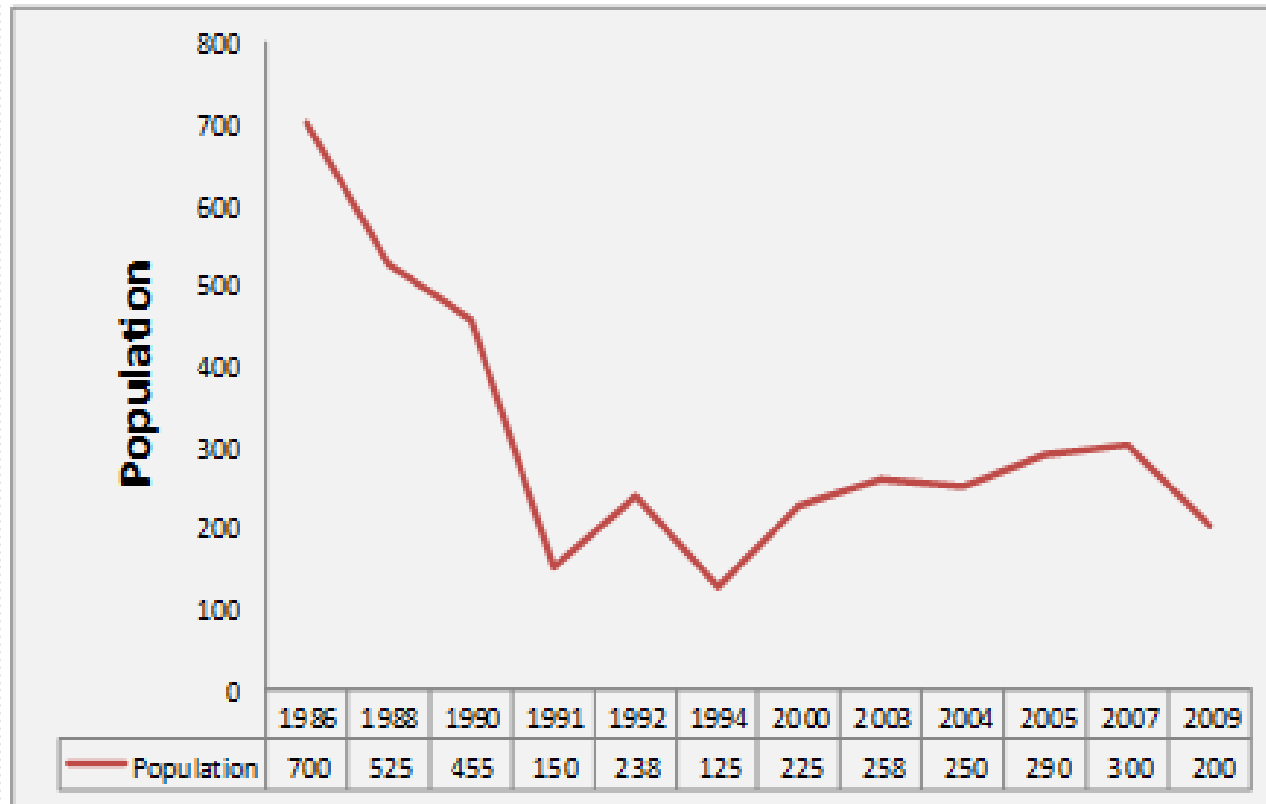
- Capacity of taskforce members built**

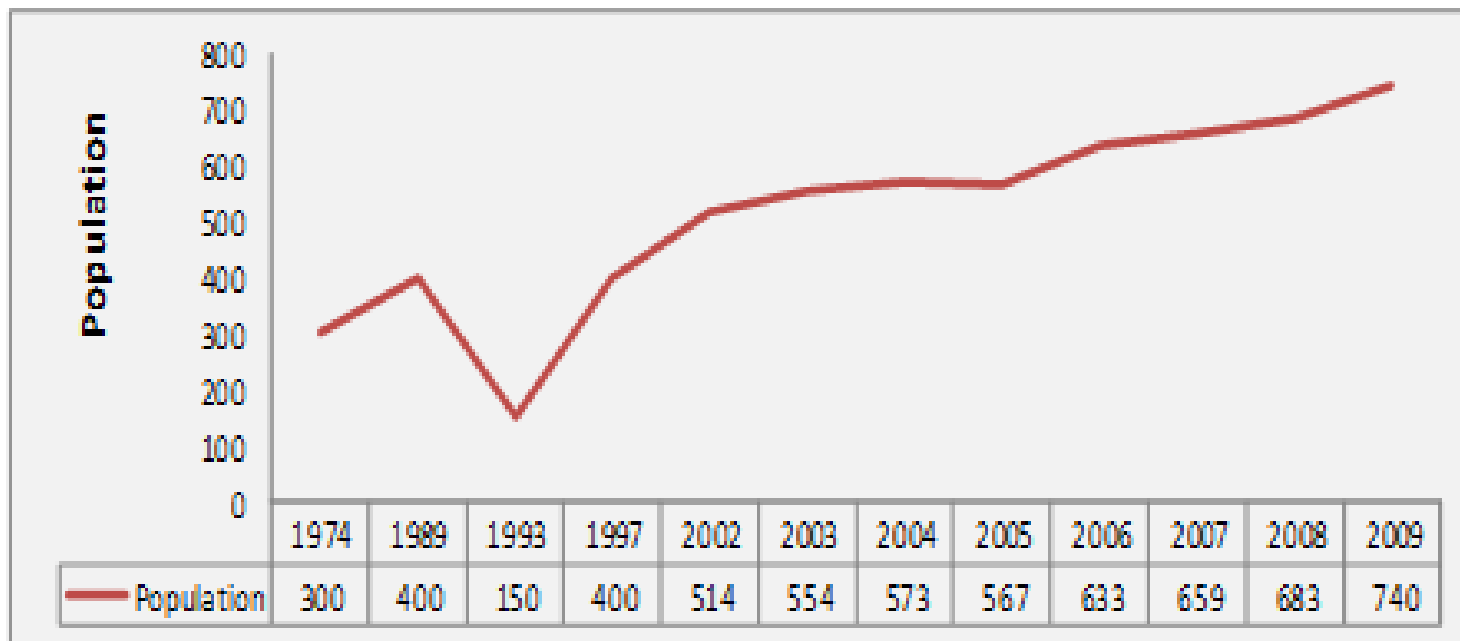

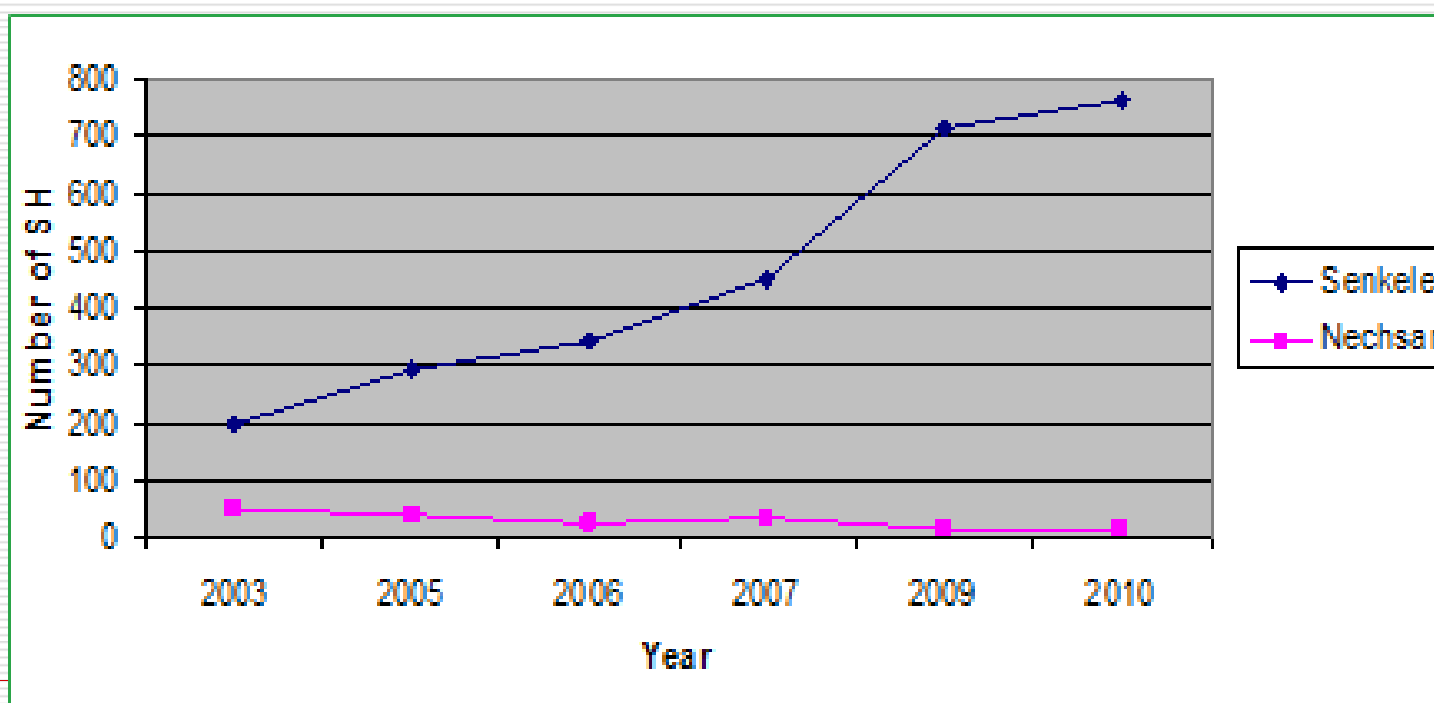






Walia ibex, adult male
