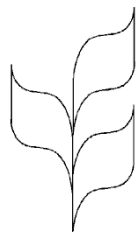

Why this seminar?

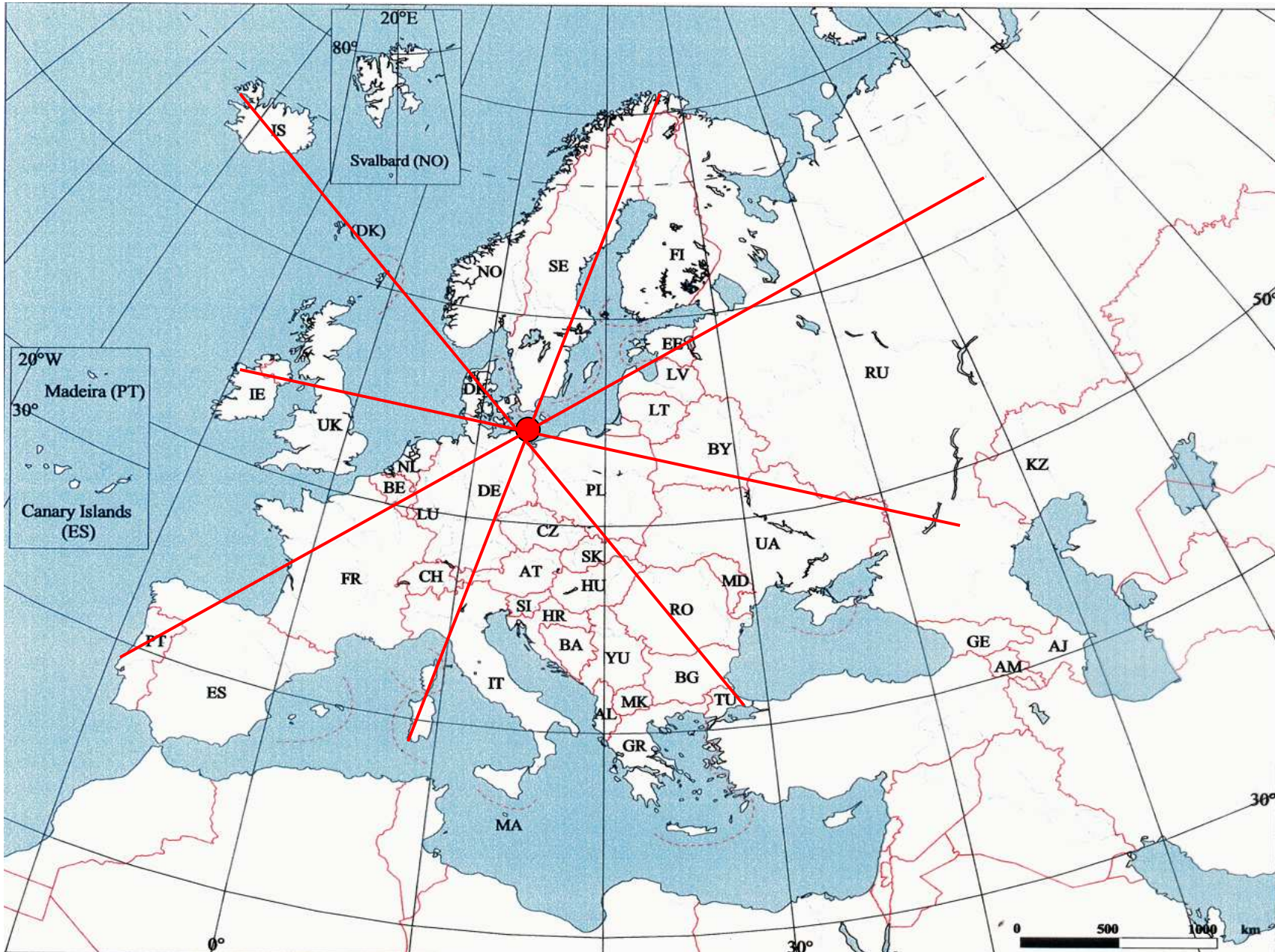
► In § 6 of Dec. VIII/8, the CBD-COP asked for **regional workshops** to discuss national experiences in implementing national biodiversity strategies and action plans (NBSAPs), and the integration of biodiversity concerns into relevant sectors. In its Rec. 2/1, the 2nd meeting of the Working Group on Review of Implementation of the Convention (July 2007) reemphasized the importance of organizing such regional workshops.

► Purpose of this workshop:
to strengthen national capacities for the **development, implementation, reviewing** and **updating** of national biodiversity strategies and action plans and the **integration** of biodiversity considerations into relevant national policies, strategies and planning processes

Why this seminar?

- ▶ NBSAPs perceived by Germany as one of the most important instruments to implement the CBD
- ▶ Germany has completed its own NBSAP a year ago and has started the implementation process
- ▶ First European regional workshop held in April 2008 at Vilm island with participants from 20 countries
- ▶ Germany hosted the CBD-COP 9 and chairing the CBD until COP 10 in 2010. This seminar should also inform the development of recommendations for COP 10

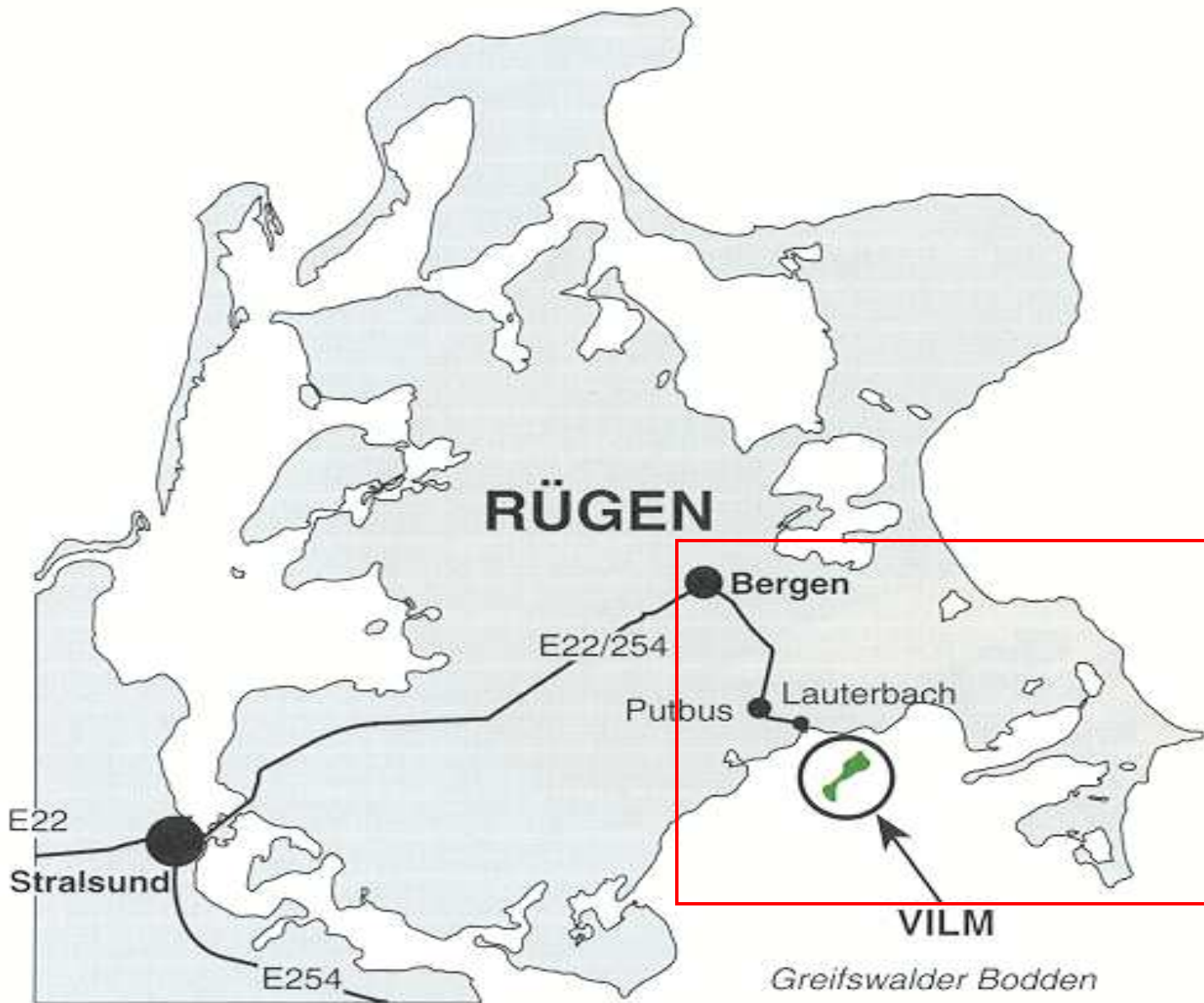
Isle of Vilm - Location in Europe

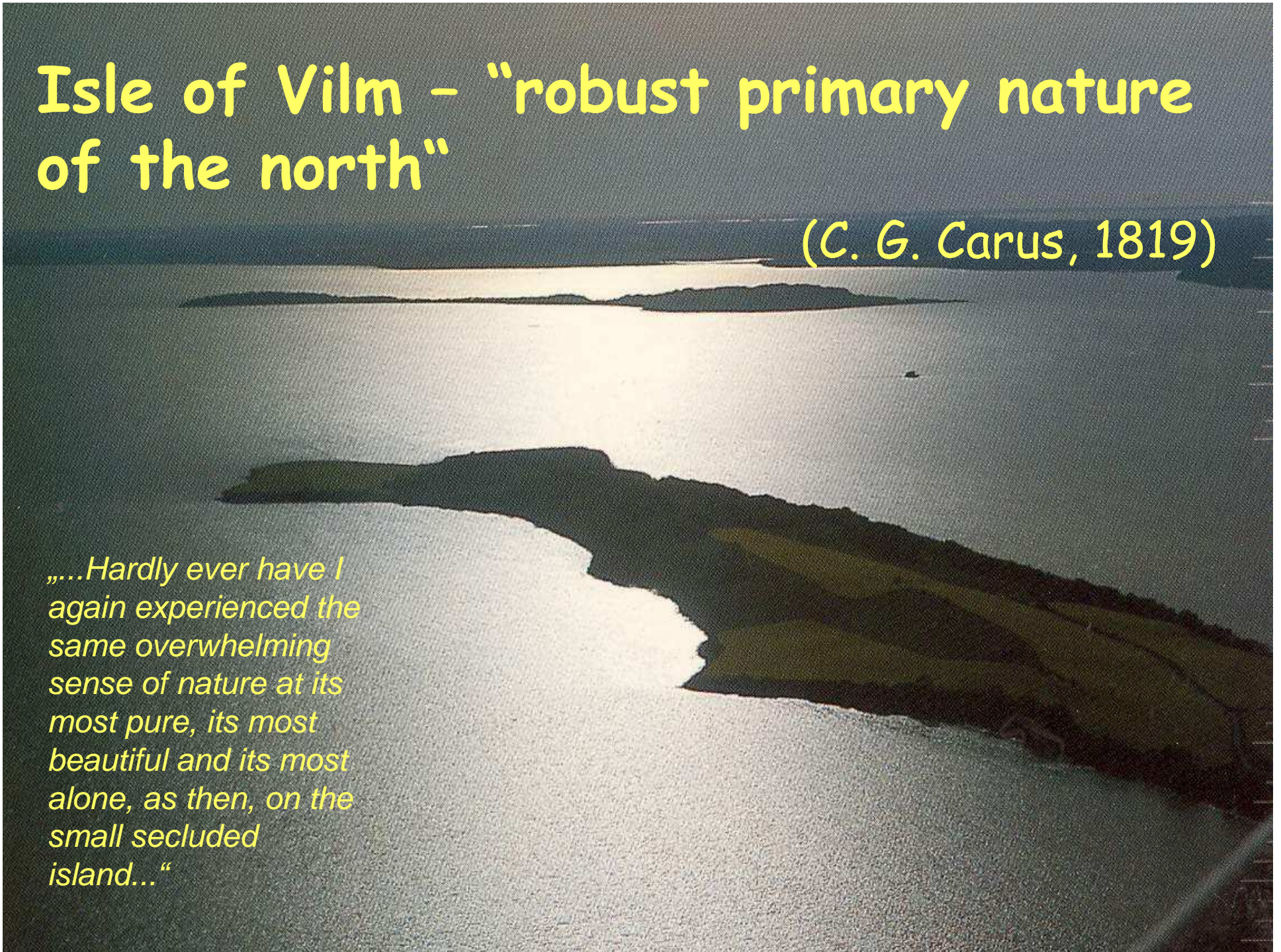




Isle of Vilm - "robust primary nature of the north"

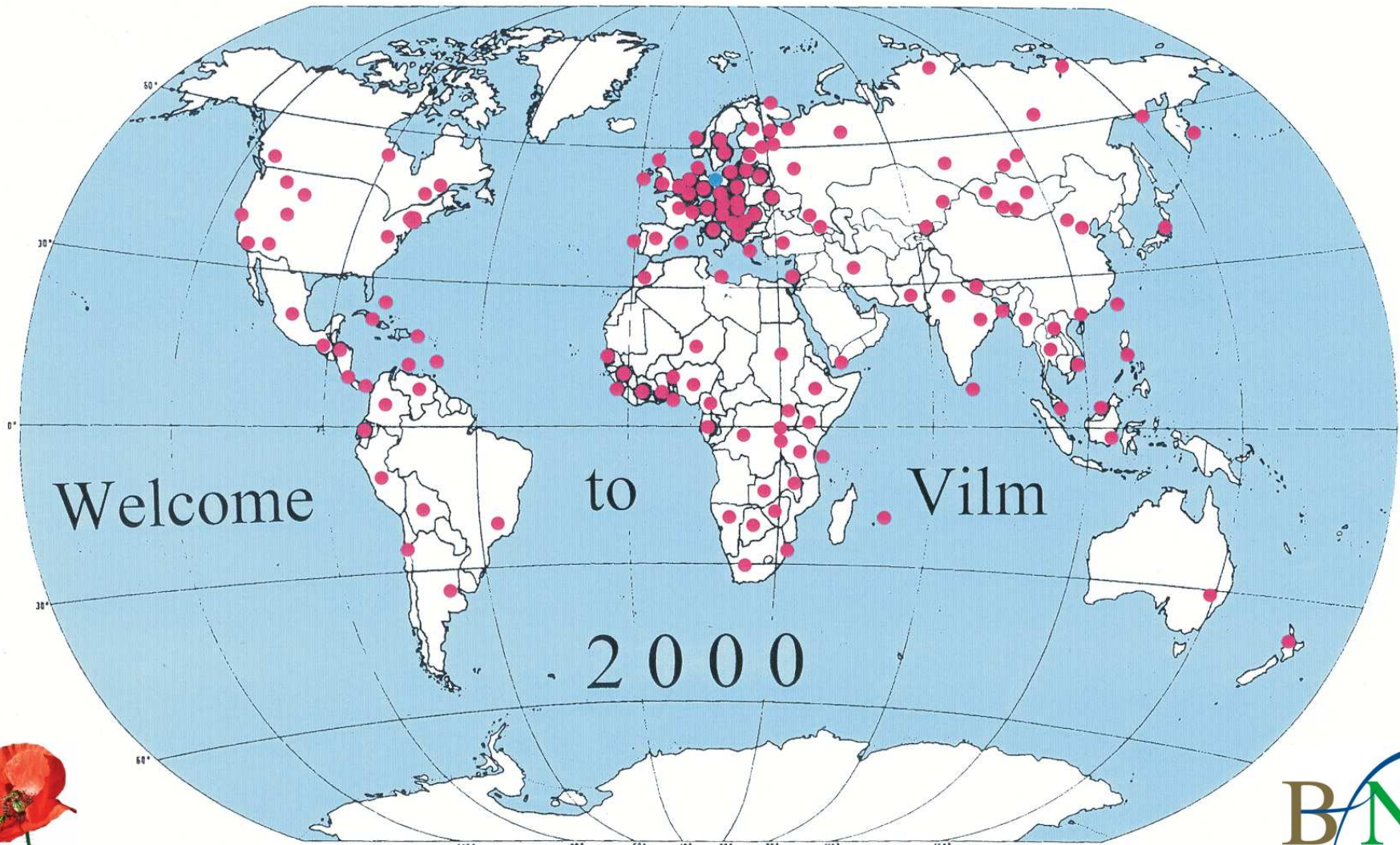
Section I 3.3 International Academy for Nature Conservation
