Why this seminar?


- In § 6 of Dec. VIII/8, the CBD-COP asked for **regional workshops** to discuss national experiences in implementing national biodiversity strategies and action plans (NBSAPs), and the integration of biodiversity concerns into relevant sectors. In its Rec. 2/1, the 2nd meeting of the Working Group on Review of Implementation of the Convention (July 2007) reemphasized the importance of organizing such regional workshops.
- Purpose of this workshop: to strengthen national capacities for the development, implementation, reviewing and updating of national biodiversity strategies and action plans and the integration of biodiversity considerations into relevant national policies, strategies and planning processes

Why this seminar?

- NBSAPs percieved by Germany as one of the most important instruments to implement the CBD
- Germany has completed its own NBSAP a year ago and has started the implementation process
- First European regional workshop held in April 2008 at Vilm island with participants from 20 countries
- Degraph of the CBD-COP 9 and chairing the CBD until COP 10 in 2010. This seminar should also inform the development of recommendations for COP 10









Lage von Vilm im Biosphärenreservat Süd-Ost-Rügen





- Promoting nature conservation issues in the work of the German development cooperation and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs






Solar panels for generating electricity: Since December 2002
