 - II. Needed to align and coordinate cooperation (based on recipient priorities)
- Paris Declaration on Aid Effectiveness calls for
 - I. Recipient ownership
 - II. Donor alignment
 - III. Harmonisation among different funds and donors (based on recipient priorities)

MANDATE TO HOST FINANCING ROUNDTABLES TO STRENGTHEN IMPLEMENTATION




Decision X/31(11-12):

Encourages donors and Parties to hold sub-regional and national donor **roundtable meetings to support mobilization of funding** based on NBSAPs and action plans for implementing the programme of work on protected areas, in collaboration with the CBD LifeWeb Initiative; and

Urges donors and countries in a position to do so **to support these funding needs**, taking into account the Paris Declaration on Aid Effectiveness.
