 Aichi Target 6: By 2020 all fish and invertebrate stocks and aquatic plants are managed and harvested sustainably, legally and applying ecosystem based approaches, so that overfishing is avoided, recovery plans and measures are in place for all depleted species, fisheries have no significant adverse impacts on threatened species and vulnerable ecosystems and the impacts of fisheries on stocks, species and ecosystems are within safe ecological limits.

Possible national targets:

 by 2020, to eliminate destructive fishing practices within national fisheries management

 Aichi Target 6: By 2020 all fish and invertebrate stocks and aquatic plants are managed and harvested sustainably, legally and applying ecosystem based approaches, so that overfishing is avoided, recovery plans and measures are in place for all depleted species, fisheries have no significant adverse impacts on threatened species and vulnerable ecosystems and the impacts of fisheries on stocks, species and ecosystems are within safe ecological limits.

Possible national targets:

- by 2020, to eliminate destructive fishing practices within national fisheries management
- by 2015, to reduce by 50% the pressure on national marine ecosystems from regional fishing activity


Who is an MEA Focal Point?

Scenario 4

 The Bakaa Valey is a fertile agricultural land in Lebanon (140 sq.Km), characterized by law rainfall, extensive dry land crops, and intensive modern horticultural varieties (Greenhouse crops). The Bekaa's agro-biodiversity, wild relatives and indigenous knowledge are under threat from modern agricultural practices including new varieties, excessive pesticide and fertilizer overuse, invasive species, overgrazing, and urbanization. As a result, the area is undergoing poor water management and overexploitation of underground water and other natural resources.

Target 2: By 2020, at the latest, biodiversity values have been integrated into national and local development and poverty reduction strategies and planning processes and are being incorporated into national accounting, as appropriate, and reporting systems

 Relevant decisions on <u>economics</u>, <u>trade and incentive</u> measures and <u>biodiversity</u> <u>for development</u>

Arab National Actions proposed involving other MEAs (Ramsar, CITES, ITPGRFA, WHC):

- Action 1: Parties may first work on bio-physical inventories of biodiversity and ecosystem services, for instance by 2012,
- **Action 2:** develop a work programme for reflecting biodiversity and ecosystem values in national accounts, for instance by 2014.
