Development of the NBSAP

- The formulation of the FNBSAP principally consisted of recommendations of reports from 6 technical groups, recommendations of 6 community workshops, and contributions from members of the FBSAP Steering Committee.
- Final draft produced in 1999 with cabinet endorsing the FNBSAP in 2003.
- FNBSAP was finally launched in September, 2007
