- As anticipated most of the core thematic areas identified in the NBSAP will be implemented under the GEFPAS 4.
- Nauru NBSAP key theme is to Rehabilitate and Conserve.
- Most Countries are revising and updating their NBSAP but we are implementing our first NBSAP.



Main Priorities NBSAP

- Conservation and Management of Island Biodiversity.
- Environment Education and Awareness (formal informal outreach, local communities engagement and involvement)
- Sustainable use and management of marine & terrestrial resources with traditional and customary land and marine tenure systems
- Develop National Policies and Legal Framework
- Capacity Building for environmental management

Progress Forward

► Implement NBSAP main core areas under the GEFPAS 4 project Integrated Island Biodiversity

Project component:

- Priorities Species and Ecosystems
- Terrestrial areas of particular importance to biodiversity conserved as conservation areas
- Marine areas of particular importance to biodiversity conserved as conservation areas
- Plans for the sustainable use of native species are developed with full stakeholder participation.
- Improved information, systems, processes are planned or in place in relevant agencies, to support implementation of the IBPOW.
- Information reviews and surveys undertaken to identify priority sites for conservation
- Legislation, regulations and policies developed for sustainable management of biodiversity and conservation area establishment
- Information management systems established or re-configured
