

Biodiversity Goal: Improve protection and conservation of biodiversity

- Conserve, preserve, and manage protected areas, wildlife, and their habitats;
- Prepare protected area management plan incorporating vulnerability and adaptability of the sector to disaster risk and climate change;
- Institute and operationalize the concept of Payment for Environmental Services (PES); and
- Continue implementing international commitments on biodiversity conservation, protection and rehabilitation





Cross-cutting Strategies

- Effective Environmental Governance
- Continued Institutional Strengthening and Capacity Building
- Research, Development, Extension and Knowledge Management
- Environment and Natural Resource Financing
