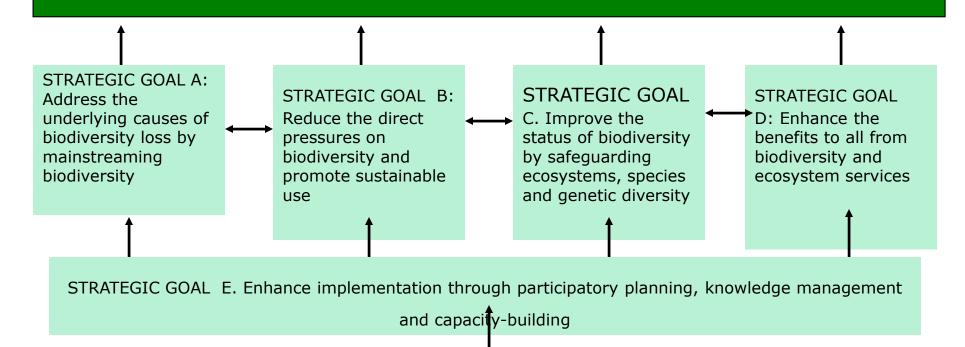


#### **VISION**
