Information Webinar on Tools to Support the Implementation of Target 6 (invasive alien species) of the Kunming-Montreal Global Biodiversity Framework 26 March 2025

Dear Sir or Madam,

In its decision 15/27, the Conference of the Parties to the Convention on Biological Diversity requested the Executive Secretary, in collaboration with the Inter-Agency Liaison Group on Invasive Alien Species and other relevant organizations, to update the online toolkit on invasive alien species of the Convention on Biological Diversity and develop additional training materials for such topics as management of priority species and pathways of introduction, identification and management of priority areas, as well as the application of international data standards in national and regional databases containing information on invasive alien species. Subsequently, in its decision 16/18, the Conference of the Parties requested the Executive Secretary to continue collaboration with the Inter-Agency Liaison Group, and to share experiences and lessons learned by the Group members that could be useful for work undertaken under the Convention in relation to invasive alien species.

In response to these requests, the Secretariat, with the support of members of the Inter-Agency Liaison Group on Invasive Alien Species, is convening an information webinar on existing tools to support the implementation of Target 6 of the Kunming-Montreal Global Biodiversity Framework. The webinar will take place on **26 March 2025** from 9:00 a.m. to 10:30 a.m. Eastern Standard Time (GMT-5) and will be conducted in English.
