

A mechanism to close the implementation gap





WWF proposal : present, review, ratchet (and repeat)

- **Present**: putting forward national biodiversity actions based on strengthened **NBSAPs** aligned with the post-2020 global biodiversity framework and its global targets.
- 2 <u>**Review</u>**: reviewing the implementation of the framework with updated national reports, and then regularly assessing progress during a global biodiversity stocktake.</u>

<u>**Ratchet</u>**: strengthening the delivery of biodiversity plans and actions, to **progressively close the implementation gap**.</u>

The implementation mechanism, an integral part of the post-2020 framework: some suggestions

Provide significant space for implementation, including the implementation mechanism, in the discussions and negotiations for the adoption of the post-2020 Global Biodiversity Framework.

- Outline the **key components** of an effective implementation mechanism **to be delivered at COP15**;
- Ensure a **shared understanding on terminologies** pertaining to the implementation mechanism;
 - Lay out a **clear roadmap** on how best to use the in-sessional and inter-sessional period to achieve concrete deliverables at COP15.
