ACTIVITIES TO COMMEMORATE INTERNATIONAL DAY FOR BIOLOGICAL DIVERSITY AND WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY 2014

The two events are being celebrated jointly from the 22nd May – 5th June, 2014. Activities included:

- A series of live television interviews will be held commencing on May 22nd for a period of 2 weeks until World Environment Day on the Government of Grenada Information Service (GIS) television. The to be discussed include:
 - Terrestrial Biodiversity
 - Marine biodiversity
 - Agriculture, Climate Change Impacts and Biodiversity on Agriculture
 - Forest biodiversity and birds
 - River biodiversity
 - National Water and Sewerage Authority (NAWASA), Climate change and water
 - Sustainable Land Management
 - RAMSAR
 - National Disaster management
 - Climate Change and its Impacts on SIDS
 - Turtle Nesting
- Production and release of a biodiversity song and a biodiversity infomercial as one of Grenada's contribution to:
 1. One of the activities in celebration of the UN Decade on Biodiversity
 2. Products produced under the Updating of the National Biodiversity Strategy and Action Plan (NBSAP) and
 3. Achievement of Goal A and Goal B of the Strategic Plan for Biodiversity 2011-2020, the Aichi Biodiversity Targets and National Implementation.
- Visits to schools around the island by officials from the Ministry of Agriculture, Lands, Forestry, Fisheries and Environment
- Unveiling of a biodiversity billboard
- Re – commencement of the night market on the 22nd May at Rainbow Inn, Grenville, St. Andrews where our local produce and traditional plants with medicinal value will be displayed. This activity is being coordinated by a Non – Governmental Organisation.
