



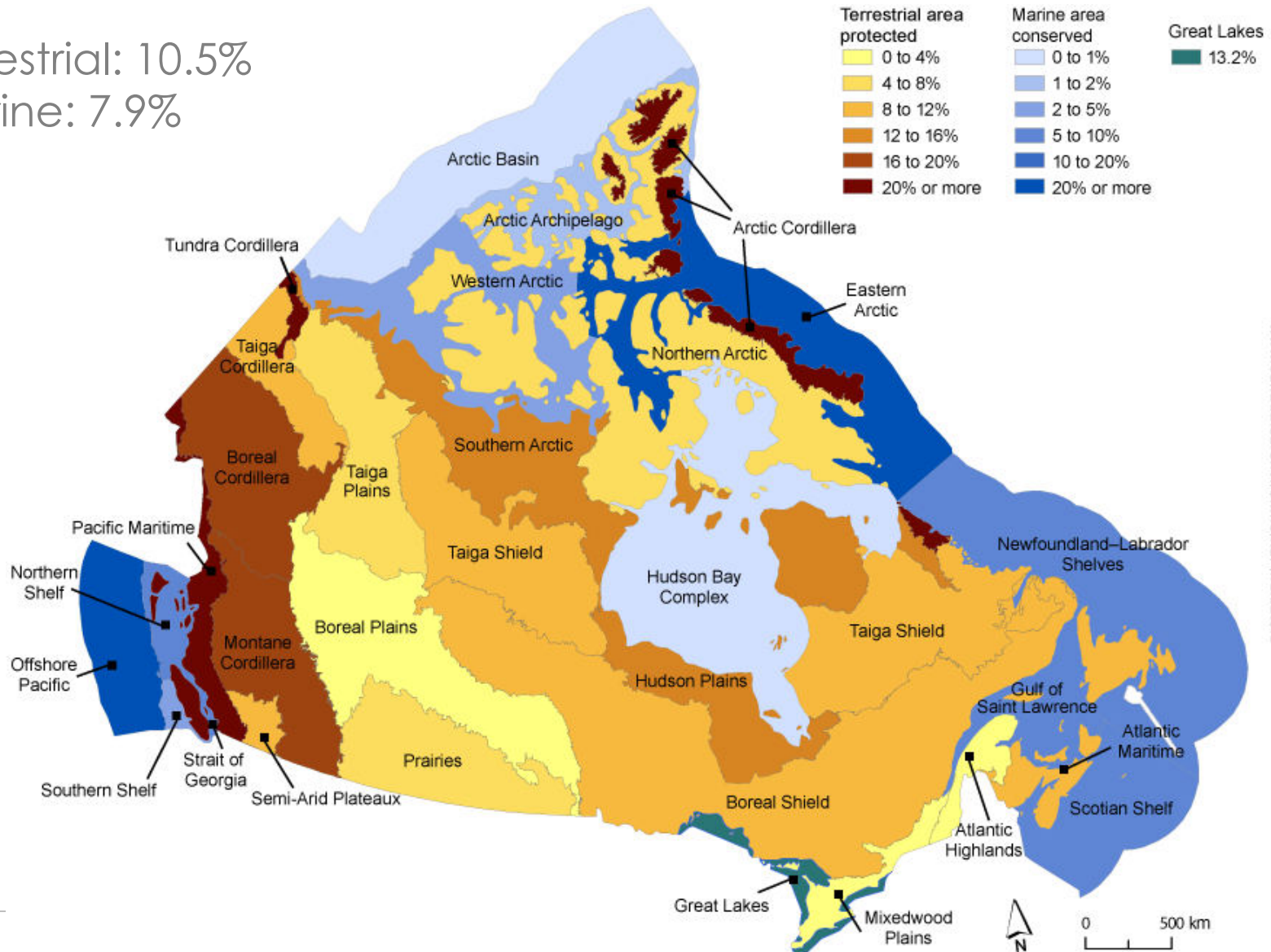

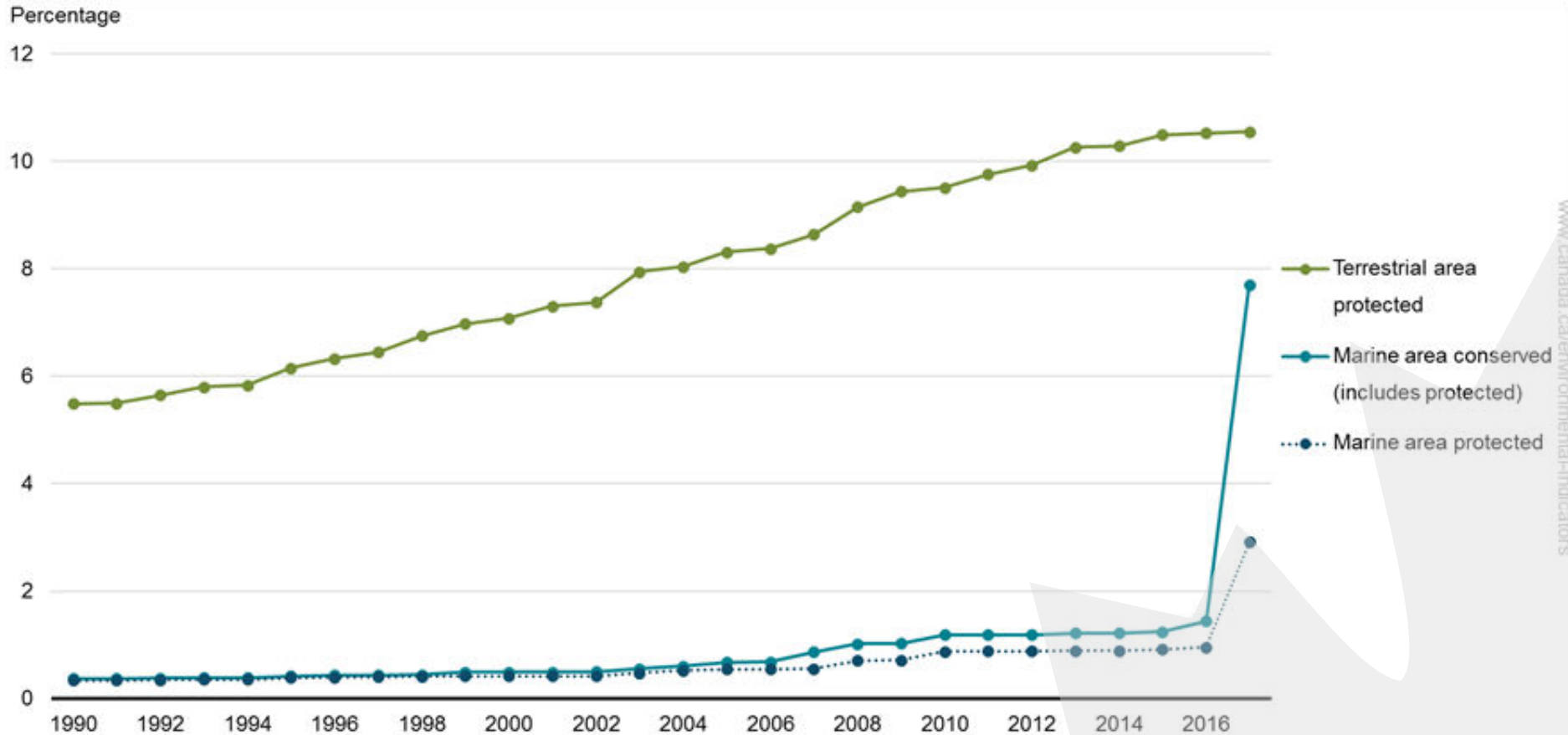
Current Progress Towards Target 11

- 2018 federal budget investment of \$1.3 billion including a \$500M Nature Fund

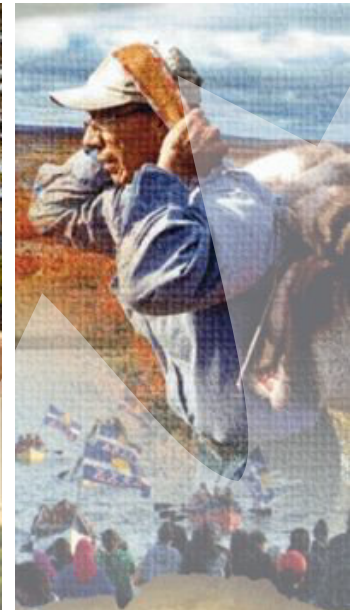
